Follow the instructions below to create your personal glyph.

- In the center of your paper, draw a large diamond. This will be the outline of a kite. If your full name has more than 15 letters, use a blue crayon. If it has less than 15 letters, use a green crayon. If it has exactly 15 letters, use a purple crayon.
- Draw a horizontal crossbar on the kite. Think about the number of vowels in your first name. If there are less than three vowels, draw a horizontal bar in orange. Use red if you have three vowels in your first name. Use yellow if you have more than three vowels.
- Use the same color scheme to draw a vertical crossbar on the kite—yellow for less than three, red for three, and orange for more than three vowels.
- If there are more syllables in your first name than in your last name, draw a sun in the sky. If there are more syllables in your last name, draw a moon. If your first and last name have the same number of syllables, draw a cloud in the sky.
- Draw a kite string. Put as many bows on the kite string as you have vowels in your first name. Color the bows with a color that has the same number of syllables as your first name.
- Draw as many birds in the sky as you have vowels in your last name.
- If you will have a birthday this month, color your kite using one color, then draw stripes on your kite in another color. Otherwise, color it in with one color only.
