

# Making Clocks

Follow the directions to create your own clock.

1. Decorate the bottom of your paper plate to resemble a ladybug using the black and red crayons or markers.
2. Use the top of the plate (the side you would eat from) as the clock face. Record the numbers 1–12 on the face of the clock in the correct position using a black marker.
3. Poke the brass fastener through both clock hands and then through the paper plate using the dot in the center of the plate as a guide for centering the clock hands.
4. You now have a ladybug clock which can be used to practice telling time.

*Materials: Paper plate, brass fastener, 2 clock hands (one long, one short)*
